Proposition No. 1

Replacement Educational Programs and Operation Levy

The Board of Directors of Sultan School District No. 311 adopted Resolution No. 21-08, concerning a proposition to finance educational programs and operation expenses. This proposition would authorize the District to levy the following excess taxes, in place of an expiring levy, on all taxable property within the District, for support of the District's General Fund educational programs and operation expenses not funded by the State of Washington:

<u>Collection Year</u>	<u>Estimated Levy Rate/\$1,000 Assessed Value</u>	<u>Levy Amount</u>
2023	\$1.50	\$3,912,643
2024	\$1.50	\$4,382,161
2025	\$1.50	\$4,820,377
2026	\$1.50	\$5,206,007

Proposition No. 2

Capital Levy for Safety, Critical Infrastructure, Technology and Transportation Facility

The Board of Directors of Sultan School District No. 311 adopted Resolution No. 21-09, concerning a proposition to finance capital improvements. This proposition would authorize the District to levy the following excess taxes on all taxable property within the District to make District-wide safety, security and critical infrastructure improvements (security cameras, fencing and roof improvements), continue funding instructional technology equipment, infrastructure and improvements, and construct a new transportation facility:

<u>Collection Year</u>	<u>Estimated Levy Rate/\$1,000 Assessed Value</u>	<u>Levy Amount</u>
2023	\$0.95	\$2,508,534
2024	\$0.95	\$2,809,558
2025	\$0.95	\$3,090,514
2026	\$0.95	\$3,337,755
